

i>Clickers

You are required to purchase an i>Clicker remote for in-class participation (available from the bookstore). If you already have an i>Clicker for a different class you do NOT need to purchase another one. i>Clicker is a response system that allows you to respond to questions we pose during class, and you will be graded on that participation. In order to receive this 25 point credit, you will need to register your i>Clicker remote online by the end of the last day to add classes (Sept 2nd). You must have come to class at least once and have voted on at least one question, in order to complete this registration properly. Once you have voted on a question in class, go to www.iclicker.com/registration. Complete the fields with your first name, last name, student ID, and remote ID. Your student ID should be your UH student ID. The remote ID is the series of numbers and sometimes letters found on the bottom of the back of your i>Clicker remote. The i>Clicker response system will be used every day in class, and you are responsible for bringing your remote daily, we do not have any spares. If you miss more than 4 classes during the semester without an excuse (illness with a Dr's note or athletes traveling to an event are excused absences), you will not get the 25 point credit.

You may not bring a friend's i>Clicker to class and operate it to obtain attendance points for them. That would be unfair to students who do attend and would be considered cheating, anyone found doing this would be subject to the student conduct code.
