## **UH Manoa Climate Research Center Hosts International Meeting**

Honolulu: The International Pacific Research Center at the University of Hawaii Manoa hosted the international meeting on climate change entitled “The Joint [IPCC-WCRP-IGBP](#) Workshop: New Science Directions and Activities Relevant to the Fifth Assessment Report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change.” The meeting was held at the East-West Center from March 3-6, 2009. The International Pacific Research Center (IPRC) of the School of Ocean and Earth Science and Technology (SOEST) at the University of Hawai'i Mānoa conducts research to gain greater understanding of the climate system and of the nature and causes of climate variations in the Asia-Pacific region, and to determine how global climate changes may affect the region. Established under the “U.S.-Japan Common Agenda for Cooperation in Global Perspective” in October 1997, the IPRC is a collaborative effort between the University of Hawaii and agencies in Japan and the United States.
