KITV recognizes that a good internship program can add practical experience to the education a student gains in college or graduate school. KITV has a long-established Internship Program, in which students may work one semester and earn academic credit working in the newsroom. KITV is now expanding the program to include students interested in weather anchoring and broadcast meteorology.

Therefore, KITV is seeking bright, motivated students in their third or fourth year of undergraduate studies to participate in an internship program with the School of Ocean & Earth Science & Technology (SOEST) at the University of Hawai`i.

The intent of the internship is two-fold.

- To establish a working relationship with SOEST students in hope that when they graduate, they may consider careers with KITV; and
- To provide SOEST students with hands-on, “real-world” training that will equip them marketable skills in the broadcast industry.

Interns will learn:

- How to analyze meteorological data and prepare the data for a weathercast;
- About computer systems used in presenting weather to a broadcast audience;
- Broadcasting skills, including vocal and visual presentation;
- How a broadcast newsroom operates, and how the weather department is integrated into it.

Only one intern will be accepted per semester. Applicants will be contacted by KITV for interviews upon receipt of a successful application.
