The purpose of these presentations is to i) facilitate communication and collaboration within each division, ii) allow faculty beyond the advisor to evaluate and provide feedback on each student's progress, and iii) provide an opportunity for the students to define and communicate their research, and to practice speaking to an audience. Presentations will be organized as an annual symposium by each division, and the date(s) will be announced beforehand to allow the greatest number of students and faculty to attend. Faculty will provide feedback to the students following the presentations; the details of this feedback are to be determined by each division.”
