### Instructions for: Doctorate - Forming the Dissertation Committee (Form I-A)

#### Use this internal ORE form to report the following:

- Approval of research *topic* (tentative title and abstract)
- Appointment of dissertation committee

#### **Committee Approval**

By signing this form, members of the committee indicate their willingness to serve on the committee and their approval of the proposed dissertation topic (tentative title and abstract).

#### **Committee Membership:**

The dissertation committee guides the student, conducts the comprehensive exam, approves the dissertation proposal (Form 2), conducts the final examination (Form 3), and approves the written dissertation (Form 4). The committee must have at least five members from the graduate faculty of UH-Mānoa. The chair and the majority of the committee members must be ORE graduate faculty members (including cooperating and affiliate graduate faculty members), and there must be at least one ORE departmental graduate faculty member on the committee. At least one member must be a UH-Mānoa faculty member who is not affiliated with the ORE graduate program, has an "arm's length" relationship with other committee and department faculty members, and is formally recognized as the University Representative.

If any of the faculty listed are not on the UH Grad Division graduate faculty list, submit a current Curriculum Vitae for the potential committee member, Form 1A filled (but not signed), and a petition to the ORE Graduate Chair explaining why they should be included on the committee. The petition, after approval and endorsement by the Graduate Chair, will be submitted for approval by the Graduate Division. Form 1A should be circulated for committee signatures after approval.
