Applicants Must Be:

- 1) A U.S. Citizen, U.S. National or Lawful Permanent Resident Alien and able to meet background check requirements. Priority will be given to Hawai‘i residents.
- 2) Between the ages of 17- 25 years old. Team Leader must be at least 21 years old.
- 3) Available full-time between June 11- August 3, 2018 (7:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.) plus travel time.
- 4) Able to provide own daily transportation to and from designated pick up sites at War Memorial Stadium in Kahului or Eddie Tam Gym in Makawao.
- 5) Able to attend mandatory orientation on June 7, 2018
- 6) Able to work outdoors at sea level and elevations between 7,000- 10,000 ft. in varying weather conditions.
- 7) Willing and able to hike on uneven terrain with a 30 lb. backpack and tools and camp in remote areas with no facilities or cell phone reception for up to a week at a time.
- 8) Able to provide own housing accommodations. Park housing is NOT available.
