REQUIREMENTS FOR A MINOR IN EARTH SCIENCES

The minor requires EARTH 101 (or 103) & 101L or EARTH 170, 200, and 11 credits hours of non-introductory Earth Sciences courses at the 300-level or higher. A minimum grade of “C” is required in these courses. The minor is flexible and can provide either an introductory survey of geology or emphasize areas of particular interest to the student. A student interested in a minor in Earth Sciences should consult with an advisor from the department to tailor a plan best suited to the student’s interest.
